OPERATING HIGHLIGHTS

Seeking to put God's love into action, Waco Habitat for Humanity brings people together to build homes, communities and hope. This past year, Waco Habitat built and sold, through no-interest loans, six new homes in Waco. We repaired 26 owner-occupied residences throughout McLennan County. The ReStore welcomed almost 21,000 customers and diverted over 5,500 tons from the landfill. None of these outcomes could be realized without some 3,200 volunteers serving alongside us to the tune of about 15,000 hours.




Financial Summary

COMMUNITY IMPACT

Since 1986, Waco Habitat for Humanity has come alongside almost 600 families across McLennan County to assure homeownership is affordable and sustainable.

Waco Habitat builds homes in partnership with people earning low incomes and sells those homes through no-interest loans. Waco Habitat has built and sold 167 new homes.

Waco Habitat comes alongside existing homeowners to help maintain homes in good repair. Over 400 repairs have helped homeowners age in place and enjoy their biggest asset: their home.

ReStore is the number one way Habitat affiliates grow capacity. Waco Habitat ReStore cover most administrative overhead, allowing each \$1 donated to Waco Habitat to go directly to build and repair homes in our community.
