One of my family members heard about Waco Habitat for Humanity and gave me the contact information. This is where my journey with Waco Habitat began."

The Waco Habitat Construction Supervisor, Jose, is committed to quality. My home was a rehabilitated property, and every detail was handled with the mindset that I deserved the very best they had to offer. It was great to watch the community come together, with people at different skill levels, to lend a hand."
